AUTHOR John F Hanley, a former deputy head teacher at Hautlieu School who grew up and worked in Jersey before retiring to Cornwall, has recently released the fifth novel in his Jack Renouf series, Under The Tide.

After he retired he began writing and published his first book, Against The Tide, in 2012, which introduced the character Jack Renouf, who, along with three of his friends, become caught up in a series of adventures, including the 1940 Helsinki Olympics and water polo at Havre des Pas.

The inspiration behind his writing is the author's fascination with the pre-war and German Occupation years, and John had often wondered what it would have been like if he had been an 18-year-old.
